

WELCOME TO OFFUTT AIR FORCE BASE

OFFUTT HAS PLAYED A MAJOR ROLE IN AMERICAN MILITARY HISTORY FOR MORE THAN A CENTURY NOW.
THIS GREAT HERITAGE BEGAN WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF FORT CROOK BETWEEN 1894 AND 1896,
JUST 10 MILES SOUTH OF OMAHA AND TWO MILES WEST OF THE MISSOURI RIVER.

The fort's namesake was Maj. Gen. George Crook, who was a renowned fighter in the American-Indian Wars and a Civil War hero.

Many of the original structures built on the post before 1900, including the guardhouse and various enlisted and officers' quarters, are still in use today.

In June 1946, the Army Air Corps re-designated Fort Crook as Offutt Field and just 18 months later it was transferred to the new Department of the Air Force, becoming Offutt Air Force Base.

In 1948, Offutt gained national prominence when it became the host base for the Strategic Air Command. It was chosen as headquarters to the U.S. Air Force's crucial long-range atomic striking force primarily because the base was centrally located on the North American continent, placing

it well beyond the range of existing potentially hostile bombers or missiles.

Through the years many units and missions have called Offutt their home. In 1966, the 55th Strategic Reconnaissance Wing moved to base and would later become the 55th Wing to match its growing mission. It became the installation's host unit in 1986.

With the disestablishment of SAC in 1992, Offutt transitioned to Air Combat Command and became the host to the new U.S. Strategic Command.

Today, the former Army outpost, once hard pressed to support a few hundred soldiers, now accommodates a combined military and civilian workforce of some 12,000 while supporting more than 22,000 family members.

55TH WING



U.S. STRATEGIC COMMAND

U.S. Strategic Command is one of the eleven unified combatant commands in the Department of Defense. Its overall mission is to deter strategic attack and employ forces, as directed, to guarantee the security of our nation and our allies. The command's assigned responsibilities include strategic deterrence; nuclear operations; space operations; joint electronic spectrum operations; global strike; missile defense; and analysis and targeting. STRATCOM's forces and capabilities underpin and enable all other Joint Force operations.



557TH WEATHER WING

The mission of the 557th Weather Wing is to maximize America's power through the exploitation of timely, accurate and relevant weather information; anytime, everywhere. The 557th is a specialized mission wing optimizing our longstanding joint, combatant command, coalition, allied, and interagency partnerships to achieve our nation's objectives. Its manning consists of more than 1,400 active duty, reserve, civilian and contract personnel and executes a \$32 million annual budget including more than \$1 million in operations and maintenance.

55TH WING

THE 55TH WING IS LARGEST IN AIR COMBAT COMMAND. OPERATING ON FOUR CONTINENTS, THE WING SUPPORTS SIX DIVERSE FLYING MISSIONS. THE FIGHTIN' FIFTY-FIFTH PROVIDES GLOBAL RECONNAISSANCE, REAL-TIME INTELLIGENCE GATHERING, COMMAND AND CONTROL, INFORMATION WARFARE, ELECTRONIC ATTACK, TREATY VERIFICATION AND COMBAT SUPPORT TO NATIONAL LEADERSHIP AND WARFIGHTING COMMANDERS.



55TH COMMUNICATIONS GROUP

MISSION

Provide superior C4ISR and national-level nuclear command and control capability to the 55th Wing, U.S. Strategic Command, partner units and the Department of Defense, globally.

ORGANIZATION

Presents over 400 military, civilian and contractor cyberspace professionals to defend, operate and maintain arguably the Air Force's most diverse array of cyber systems to include multiple military satellite and radio communications platforms and secure and non-secure voice and data networks. The 55th CG seamlessly integrates cyberspace operations into missions, mission systems, and processes in order to drive cybersecurity updates in wing standard operating procedures, tactics, techniques and procedures, and capabilities and requirements. As cyberspace professionals, continue to grow and evolve functional knowledge, skills, abilities and experience by proactively searching and seizing developmental opportunities to enhance technical acumen.

OPERATIONS

In addition to ensuring world-class cyber security and capability to strategic partners, national leadership and warfighters, the 55th CG deployed more than 100 cyber Airmen to numerous locations over the past year.



55TH ELECTRONIC COMBAT GROUP

MISSION

Provides combat-ready EC-130H Compass Call aircraft, crews, maintenance and operational support to the unified combatant commanders. Plans and executes information operations and electronic warfare for contingency operations. Conducts EC-130H aircrew initial qualification and difference training for 11 aircrew specialties. Supports operational and force development testing and evaluation for new aircraft systems.

ORGANIZATION

The 924-member strong 55th ECG operates 11 EC-130H Compass Call aircraft valued at \$1.7B. As the only Electronic Combat Group in the Air Force, the 55th ECG is solely responsible for training, maintaining and employing electronic attack in support of combatant commanders. To accomplish this mission, the ECG is comprised of five squadrons: 41st ECS, 42nd ECS, 43rd ECS, 755th OSS and 755th AMXS.

OPERATIONS

The 55th ECG has deployed to 12 locations since 9/11, becoming Air Combat Command's most utilized C-130 in the Air Force. Currently, the ECG is deployed in support of Operation Freedom's Sentinel and since 2002, has flown more than 87,000 combat hours during more than 14,000 sorties. The ECG also played significant roles in Operations Enduring Freedom, Iraqi Freedom, Willing Spirit, Odyssey Dawn, Unified Protector, Inherent Resolve and other classified missions of international significance.

55TH MAINTENANCE GROUP

MISSION

World's greatest maintainers, providing safe, efficient and compliant maintenance....always!

ORGANIZATION

The 55th MXG is comprised of 1,200 military, civilian, and contractor technicians responsible for fleet health & global logistics operations. To accomplish the mission, the 55th MXG is comprised of two squadrons: 55th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron and the 55th Maintenance Squadron.

OPERATIONS

The 55th MXG executes an annual budget of \$18M and 13,000 hour flying-hour program. The focus of our operation is to maximize fleet health and aircraft availability for 17: RC-135VW Rivet Joint; 3: RC-135S Cobra Ball; 2: RC-135U Combat Sent; 2: WC-135CW Constant Phoenix; 2: OC-135B Open Skies; and 3: TC-135 aircraft valued at \$6.3 billion. Personnel from the 55th MXG were continuously deployed to the Middle East for more than 29 years.



55TH MEDICAL GROUP

MISSION

Ensure medically ready forces, develop expeditionary medics, and deliver trusted care.

ORGANIZATION

The 55th Medical Group is comprised of 621 members divided into four highly-capable squadrons. The MDG boasts approximately 370 personnel that are deployment ready. The remaining personnel are a

combination of mission oriented federal civilians and contract employees who help sustain the day-to-day healthcare operations.

The MDG also operates Air Combat Command's only Personnel Reliability and Assurance Program clinic supporting more than 1,000 members across the 55th Wing, U.S. Strategic Command and the 595th Command & Control Group, ensuring NC2 fidelity and dominant ISR capability.

OPERATIONS

The 55th MDG provides healthcare to approximately 44,000 Department of Defense beneficiaries. This care includes: 149,000 annual medical and dental appointments, 319,000 annual prescriptions, 112,000 labs and 35,000 diagnostic images. The MDG also provides post-graduate education and training for 80 medical and dental personnel annually. Operational duties include advising the 55th Wing on medical, environmental, public health, and readiness issues impacting wing assets and Team Offutt's partner units.



55TH MISSION SUPPORT GROUP

MISSION

To provide customer-focused mission support for infrastructure, security, contracting, manpower personnel, services and logistics to enable dominant ISR, EA, C2 and precision awareness to national leadership and war fighters across the spectrum any time, any place.

ORGANIZATION

The 55th MSG's team of five squadrons totaling 1,600 military, civilian and contractor personnel provide dedicated support to Air Combat Command's largest wing, more than 50 partner units (including STRATCOM and the 557th Weather Wing), and a community of 44,000 active duty personnel, family members and retirees.

55TH MISSION SUPPORT GROUP OPERATIONS

The 55th MSG provides around-the-clock support at home and abroad for the longest continuously deployed wing in the Air Force. The Installation Deployment Readiness cell works with unit deployment managers to ensure wing personnel and equipment are ready for deployment at a moment's notice. On average, nearly 13% of wing personnel are deployed at any given time supporting operations around the globe. The 55th MSG deployed 207 of its own Airmen this year alone to accomplish missions across seven different Combatant Commands. In addition to deploying, the group develops and cares for our Airmen and families daily through an array of quality programs and services, enabling our Airmen to focus on the mission while strengthening relationships with our surrounding community. Furthermore, the MSG provides a safe and secure environment for Offutt's operations by delivering exceptional integrated base defense, contracting, fuels, supply, fire and emergency services and civil engineering support.



55TH OPERATIONS GROUP

MISSION

Provide premier airborne intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance and electronic warfare forces to national leadership, intelligence partners and warfighters.

ORGANIZATION

The 2,339-member strong 55th OG operates 17 RC-135V/W Rivet Joint, 3 RC-135S Cobra Ball, 2 RC-135U Combat Sent, 2 WC-135C/W Constant Phoenix, 2 OC-135B Open Skies and 3 TC-135 trainer aircraft valued at \$6.3 billion.

The 55th OG is comprised of 12 squadrons and 1 Detachment: 38th RS, 45th RS, 343rd RS, 82nd RS, 95th RS, 95th RS Det. 1, 338th CTS, 55th OSS, 97th IS, 390th IS, 488th IS and 55th ISS.

OPERATIONS

The 55th OG is responsible for training aircrews, flying global airborne missions in support of Combatant Commanders, treaty monitoring, for the President of the United States and Secretary of Defense and conducting intelligence analysis and reporting.



170TH GROUP, NEBRASKA AIR NATIONAL GUARD

Activated on June 26, 2007, the 170th Group administratively organizes Nebraska ANG members assigned to Offutt under the Offutt AFB Future Total Force Initiative. The 170th evolved from Detachment 1, Headquarters Nebraska ANG established in June 2002. Under this initiative, highly qualified ANG instructor aircrew integrate into the 338th Combat Training Squadron to provide initial qualification, re-qualification and upgrade training to active duty and ANG aircrew members.

Within the 170th Group, these instructors are part of the Nebraska ANG's 238th Combat Training Squadron. Likewise, experienced ANG personnel integrate into various sections within the 55th Operations Support Squadron to increase their capability to support the global operations of the 55th Wing. These functional areas include requirements, weapons and tactics, intelligence, base operations, weather and aviation resource management. Within the 170th Group, ANG members are part of the NE ANG's 170th Operations Support Squadron. Overall, the 170th Group consists of 80 authorized personnel, to include 25 full-time and 45 traditional, or part-time, ANG members.

U. S. STRATEGIC COMMAND

U.S. Strategic Command, one of ten unified combatant commands of the Department of Defense, is responsible for detecting, deterring and preventing strategic attacks against the United States, its allies and partners, and is prepared to deliver warfighting capability to defend the nation. USSTRATCOM responds to today's complex, dynamic and uncertain global security environment with an integrated organization. The command executes a diverse set of global responsibilities in coordination with other combatant commands and appropriate U.S. government agencies that directly contribute to national security.

The headquarters element employs more than 2,250 people, representing all four military services, Department of Defense civilians and contractors, who oversee the command's global operations – 24 hours a day, seven days a week. A global combatant command with trans-regional areas of responsibility, USSTRATCOM has evolved from a single focus on nuclear war-planning to an integrated portfolio of dynamic strategic capabilities to successfully redefine global deterrence and confront the full range of national security challenges with timely, effective and precision effects.

As of October 2018, USSTRATCOM is charged with seven mission areas as assigned by the Unified Command Plan: strategic deterrence, nuclear operations, space operations, joint electromagnetic spectrum operations, global strike, missile defense and analysis and targeting. These mission areas are critical to deterring strategic attack against

the United States and providing assurance to our allies. They provide the nation with a safe, secure, effective and ready nuclear deterrent force and deliver comprehensive warfighting solutions. They address challenges in space with capability, capacity and resilience and they build sustaining and supporting partnerships. Finally, they anticipate change and confront uncertainty with agility and innovation.

While the USSTRATCOM headquarters focuses primarily on command and control and strategic-level integration and advocacy for these missions, day-to-day planning and execution for the primary mission areas are performed by service-specific component commands, including Air Force Global Strike Command, Barksdale AFB, La., U.S. Army Forces Strategic Command, Redstone Arsenal, Ala., Fleet Forces Command, Naval Support Activity Hampton Roads Norfolk, Va., Marine Corps Forces U.S. Strategic Command, Offutt AFB, Neb., and Air Force Space Command, Peterson AFB, Colo.; joint functional component commands; task forces; and a center that trains, equips and resources the forces necessary to carry out USSTRATCOM's global missions. These organizations leverage the expertise and operational capabilities within their ranks to support all combatant commands, making maximum use of all resources against emerging threats. As of October 2018, the major USSTRATCOM components include two joint force component commanders, a joint functional component command and one center.

JFACC conducts kinetic (nuclear and conventional) and non-kinetic effects planning and execution. JFACC manages global force air activities to assure allies and to deter and dissuade actions detrimental to the United States and its global interests; should deterrence fail, employs global strike air forces (bombers and ICBMs) in support of combatant commander objectives.

FSCC directs assigned and attached USSTRATCOM space forces providing tailored, responsive, theater and global space effects in support of national objectives. JFSCC executes operational command and control of space forces through the Combined Space Operations Center (CSpOC) at Vandenberg AFB.

JOINT FUNCTIONAL COMPONENT COMMAND FOR INTEGRATED MISSILE DEFENSE, SCHRIEVER AFB, COLO.

Synchronizes operational-level global missile defense planning, operations support, and the development of missile defense effects for the Department of Defense. When directed, also provides alternate missile defense execution support.

JOINT WARFARE ANALYSIS CENTER, DAHLGREN, VA.

Provides combatant commands, Joint Staff, and other customers with precise technical solutions in order to carry out the national security and military strategies of the U.S. JWAC maintains and enhances its ability to conduct comprehensive technical analysis.

557TH WEATHER WING

The mission of the 557th Weather Wing, the Air Force's only weather wing, is to exploit timely, accurate, and relevant weather information anytime and everywhere on the globe. This is done by providing around-the-clock authoritative terrestrial and space-environmental data, analyses, forecasts, threat-warning and threat-mitigation products and services for the Department of Defense, military services, all geographic and functional combatant commands, the National Intelligence Community, White House Situation Room, interagency, allied and coalition partners around the world across multiple security enclaves.

The men and women of the 557th embrace a proud heritage of maximizing America's military power. From the D-Day invasion to Operations Enduring Freedom, Iraqi Freedom and Inherent Resolve, the wing's weather and cyber professionals have been enabling warfighters to achieve multi-domain decision superiority by mitigating atmospheric and solar threats to execution from the strategic to operational to tactical levels of warfare.

Headquartered at Offutt, the 557th is comprised of 1,450 personnel in two groups and 12 squadrons spanning 19 globally dispersed locations. Through the 1st and 2nd Weather Groups, the wing integrates leading-edge threat-based weather forecasts and warnings, as well as climatological projection and solar-threat expertise, into all operational phases. From managing daily risk for protection of personnel and resources, to shaping warfighter planning and execution of kinetic and non-kinetic engagements, to enabling long-range strategic basing decisions, the 557th empowers decision makers to "Choose the weather for battle" and achieve the nation's objectives.



595TH COMMAND & CONTROL GROUP

The 595th Command & Control Group, located at Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska, is a geographically separated unit of Eighth Air Force. Established in 2016, the group consolidates all of the Air Force's Nuclear Command and Control Communications into one unit.

The 595th C2G is comprised of four squadrons: the 1st Airborne Command Control Squadron, which operates the E-4B National Airborne Operations Center; the 595th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, responsible for sustainment and upkeep of the E-4B; the 595th Strategic Communication Squadron, provides real-time, secure, nuclear survivable missile warning and C3 capabilities; the 625th Strategic Operations Squadron maintains current and accurate targeting for the nation's Intercontinental Ballistic Missile fleet and combat forces for two positions on board the U.S. Navy's E-6B Mercury Strategic Command Airborne Command Post aircraft.


