Col. Julie R. Ostrand is the Commander, 55th Medical Group, 55th Wing, Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska. She is responsible for a four-squadron, 612-person health care delivery system providing care to more than 51,000 Department of Defense beneficiaries. She oversees the post-graduate education and training of more than 150 medical and dental personnel annually, to include the 55th Medical Group Family Medicine Residency and Dental Residency Programs. Additionally, she serves as the principal medical advisor to the 55th Wing Commander and is responsible for providing comprehensive health services to maintain the highest degree of readiness in support of contingency war mobilization and Homeland Defense plans for Offutt Air Force Base, 50 associate units, U.S. Strategic Command and the 557th Weather Wing

Col. Ostrand was commissioned into the Nurse Corps in 1992 after completing her Bachelors of Arts in Nursing. In 2005 she earned a Master of Science in Nursing from the University of Minnesota Twin Cities and became a board certified Women's Health Nurse Practitioner. Additionally, Col. Ostrand is a 2015 Air War College graduate.
