The intent of the Honorary Commander Program is to educate community leaders about the Air Force and this installation. The program will foster public trust and support by familiarizing community leaders with the customs, courtesies, rigors, demands, and camaraderie of U.S. Air Force at Offutt Air Force Base. This application is our first step to selecting qualified participants for the program. Because the intent of the program is to educate community leaders who are not and have not been directly involved with the military or Offutt, there are a few stipulations on serving as an Honorary Commander.

Applicants may not be: immediately related to anyone who has been or is currently an Honorary Commander; a military retiree (or the spouse of a military retiree); any reporter affiliated with news media; federally elected or appointed to current professional position; or employed by a DOD contractor.

Please note that filling out this application does not guarantee a spot in the program, but merely gives the base an idea of your interest in the program and qualifications. In general, Honorary Commanders serve for two years, typically starting in the fall. However, some terms may be shorter or longer depending on a variety of circumstances.
